ICT and the aluminium industry: strategies for success

It is the title of the 2nd IT Metal international conference organised by **ITmetal.it** and **CSMT** which will be held on Saturday, April 17th at 10:00 AM.

The increasing level of competitiveness and market turmoil is leading many companies to increase investments in **Information Technology (IT)** to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of their processes. The metals sector is not exempt from this trend. Nevertheless, compared to increasingly significant investments, the real benefits of the technologies implemented are not always obvious or at least do not always appear to be proportionate to the resources involved. Through the analysis of diverse international companies in the metallurgical sector, both in the extractive and processing-

manufacturing fields, during the presentation the advantages and disadvantages of the application of information technologies will be highlighted with particular reference to integrated ERP systems.

The speaker will also highlight the organizational and industrial contexts most suited for the utilisation of the characteristics of these technologies and it will be suggested that to maximize benefits when investing in IT, the skills acquired during the implementation of a system must be aligned with the needs arising from the operational context of the company. Finally, practical models to facilitate this alignment process will be presented.

- Emotional Management: choose rationally and not guided by emotions (anxiety or excessive enthusiasm);

The results of the NADIA Project will be presented at METEF

*The results of the **NADIA Research Project** (New Automotive components Designed for and manufactured by Intelligent processing of light Alloys) will be presented at METEF-FOUNDEQ 2010 on Friday 16 April at 11:00 am. The project is financed by the European Union with 7.2 million Euros and sees the participation of **26 industrial** and university partners.*

*The objective of the Nadia project is to explore, for the European transport industry, the potential of light alloys to produce **components and systems for cars and trucks** through the use of nano and micro technologies.*

In addition to the University of Padua (Vicenza branch), Enginsoft, as the coordinator, Raffineria Metalli Capra, LPM, Teksid Aluminium, and the Fiat Research Centre have taken part in the project which began in 2006.

The foreign partners are also very qualified, including Ford, Daimler, Magma and the University of Trondheim.

Innovation in the rolling of light alloys

*On 14 April at 2:00 pm a round table is scheduled, entitled **Rolling of light alloys: wide spread innovation to transcend the crisis.***

*At the table, we will discuss with experts of different areas of technology to show, based on experiences and projects, the effects of the latest innovative trends in a sector which has undergone great changes over the past decade and is now represented by about **400 plants** in many countries.*

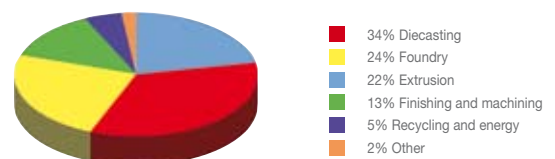

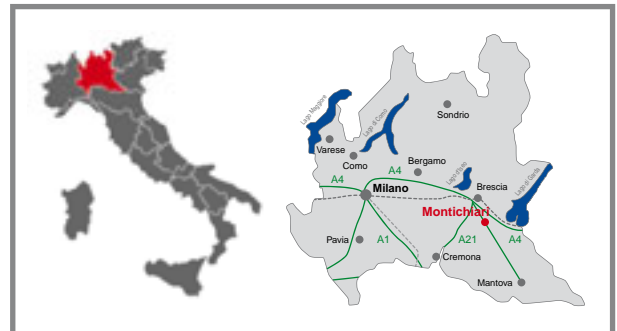
